Three fundamental principles, putting our mission in a nutshell:

1. We are partners.

We make meetings in worldwide partnerships possible to learn from each other, to vouch for each other, and to stand up with each other.

Biblical reference:

„For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.”(1 Corinthians 12:12-13)

2. We design projects.

We design joint projects out of our partnerships where people organize to create social fairness and thus let light up the Kingdom of God.

Biblical reference:

*"Then the LORD said, "I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters. I know their sufferings, and I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a good and broad land, a land flowing with milk and honey ... Come, I will send you"
(Exodus 3:7-8, 10)*

3. We make politics.

Our commitment leads to consequences for our lifestyle, our actions as an international association and for our political work to obtain worldwide social fairness.

Biblical reference:

"Go your way; behold, I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves. ... say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'" (Luke 10:3, 9)

Visionary reference:

"And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new."
